- Crafts Group: Last year, we tried out a jewelry-making class on Tuesday afternoons at the Cushing Café (2/4-3/25/25). People who joined us expressed an interest in a weekly/bi weekly crafts group. We’re looking to find a day and time that works for the majority of those who wish to join us.

- Friday Night Free Movie (1/30/26): For our January movie, we'll be sharing the auditorium with Student Services. We will be showing Flow (2024). We're leaning towards showing The Princess Bride (1987) in February. If you have any suggestions or ideas, they are more than welcome.
- Hikes: With the colder winter weather coming, we're hoping to get some hikes going again. Please reach out if you have people interested.
- Concerts/Plays/etc.: If your house has interest in any local concerts or shows feel free to reach out and see if our rec department has access to free or discounted tickets. ## **Upcoming Activities/Ideas:**

- February/Valentines Day Dinner and Dance: We're planning another night of dining and dancing for February with the idea of restarting our Adult Services Dances. We have the auditorium reserved for Thursday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, for a Valentine's and/or winter dinner and dance. As we still have ample time to plan, we can move this date if necessary. The thought behind holding it on Thursday the 12<sup>th</sup> is that most people will be around (we have a number of folks who leave on Fridays to visit families), it won't conflict with the Plymouth dances a lot of our people enjoy (usually the second to last Thursday of the month) and it's close to the Valentines holiday (Saturday 2/14/26). - NSRWA Estuary Explorers Program: We are moving forward with a partnership with the NSRWA (the North and South River Watershed Association <https://www.nsrwa.org/>) through their Estuary Explorers Program. All of these activities are weather permitting and the idea is to start with small groups of people who shown interest, assessing how these activities work for us and growing from there.
