Other Activities/Ideas:

- Paint Night: Our next project started Tuesday 9/23/25. If you are interested in joining a paint night please let me know. We have Tuesday and Thursdays open for paint nights. If there's a need for a different day/night we can try to accommodate.
 - Our current theme is "Trees". We'll be doing a portrait layout landscape concentrating on sky, grass and a lone tree. Artists will see a quick demonstration and then will be free to paint what and how they want. We'll be using primary colors again (Pthalo Blue, Magenta and Chrome Yellow) plus white.
 - We will again try to keep groups to 3-5 people
 - Locations will be chosen to best fit the groups.
 - If you have people interested please send me names and days/dates, we've already received some requests and we'll try to honor those first
 - We'll be using acrylics and will provide brushes, paints and canvas boards.

Upcoming Activities/Ideas:

- NSRWA Estuary Explorers Program: We are moving forward with a partnership with the NSRWA (the North and South River Watershed Association <https://www.nsrwa.org/>) through their Estuary Explorers Program. This will offer small groups of our folks access to coastal scavenger hunts, guided discovery tours, water salinity sampling, and kayak tours. All of these activities are weather permitting and the idea is to start with small groups of people who shown interest, assessing how these activities work for us and growing from there. - Documentary Film Nights: We're seeing if there's interest in having a science/art themed monthly/bimonthly Documentary Film Night.
