Other July Activities/News

Clubs: Due to popular demand we are starting to offer afternoon clubs starting with Art, Crafts, Photography and Grilling and weekend (possibly weekday too...) of Walking and Hiking. The idea is to use the Large Sun Conference Room in Fatima B (the new Adult Services offices on "The Hill") as our meeting place (except for walking and hiking) but this could change due to the heat and accessibility issues. If we get an overwhelming amount of people interested we'll split the groups into manageable sizes and add in some different days to meet.

1. Photography Club: The Rec Hall is letting us use 4-5 of their digital cameras but people are welcome to bring their own. The idea is to start with the basics by taking pictures around campus and then start moving outward to local areas of interest/historical significance and beauty. Pictures will then be shared and discussed with the possibility of displaying them in a show.
2. Crafts Club: Based on the success of our Jewelry Making Class we'll meet once a month (to start) to work on various craft activities and plan our projects around who is interested.
3. Art Club: We'll explore various mediums (pencil, charcoal, acrylics, multimedia) and possibly visit some local art shows/museums with the idea that we work towards a small display or art show.
4. Grilling Club: Location/Date/Time TBA We're hoping to use some of the vegetables and herbs grown in our house gardens to come together in small groups to learn how to BBQ and create healthy summer meals.
5. Walking & Hiking Club: Weekends seem to be our best bets for free time and weather but we'll plan weekday/evening meets based on weather
6. Gardens: 7 of our 15 houses now have gardens/planters/raised beds. Vegetables, herbs and flowers were available to our houses for free from the Greenhouse/Garden Center on campus while. In June Washington Street was generously given a large raised bed/planter by Dylan O'Brien as part of his Eagle Scout project. Wednesday July 8th there will be a small ceremony at Washington Street where a plaque will be placed on the planter and several Hanover dignitaries will be present. If your house would like to participate in growing a garden next year please reach out and we can start the planning.

Pool Parties: We had our first Pool Party Wednesday June 24th, from 5:00-7:00pm. 11/15 houses joined us with 44 of our 63 people attending from our 15 houses. We offered only healthy options with seltzers and

bottled water and a free salad bar with two types of grilled chicken. Houses were tasked with bringing their own dinners. We'll continue with this format to make it easier on those individuals we serve who have struggles with making healthy choices as there are ample opportunities elsewhere for burgers, hotdogs and pizza. If the weather cooperates we'll have our next Adult Services pool party Monday July 13th with the option of moving it to a better day as we get closer and get more accurate weather forecasts.

Free Summer Concerts: Abington (Sundays @6:00pm) and Plymouth (Wednesdays 6:30-9:00pm) offer free summer concerts that many of our houses have attended over the years. Various other South Shore towns offer them as well but traditionally the Abington/Plymouth concerts have worked best for our folks.
